Motley Fool Hat

(Adult Size)

1 skein Worsted Weight Yarn Needles: Size 9 circular needle (16"), and Double points, size 9 to finish the top Buttons to sew on I cord ends!

Cast on 90 sts, joining in the round, and then knit 3, purl 2 until your hat measures 6 inches.

On the next round, decrease 1 st in the knit section, and work 1 round even. (72 sts remaining)

Next round, purl 2 together in the purled rib, and work 1 round even (there will be knit 2 sts, and purl 1 st. (54 sts)

Continue decreasing – on next round knit 2 tog in the knitted section, and purl 1 st. Work 1 round even. (This round will be k 1, p 1) (36sts)

Then, knit 2 together all around. Knit 1 round even. (18 sts)

Again, knit 2 together all around (9 sts)

Thread a tapestry needle with the working yarn and draw up tightly. Sew end to inside of hat.

Now make 2 separate I cords (4 sts each) of different lengths. (More I cords are optional) Sew them to top of hat, and then attach a button to the tip of the cord which hangs down the back of the hat when worn.
