

# FRUGAL KNITTING HAUS FREE PATTERN

## Easy Infant Sweater

Can be made easily in 2 days!  
Make a wardrobe of colors for each day  
of the week.

### Size:

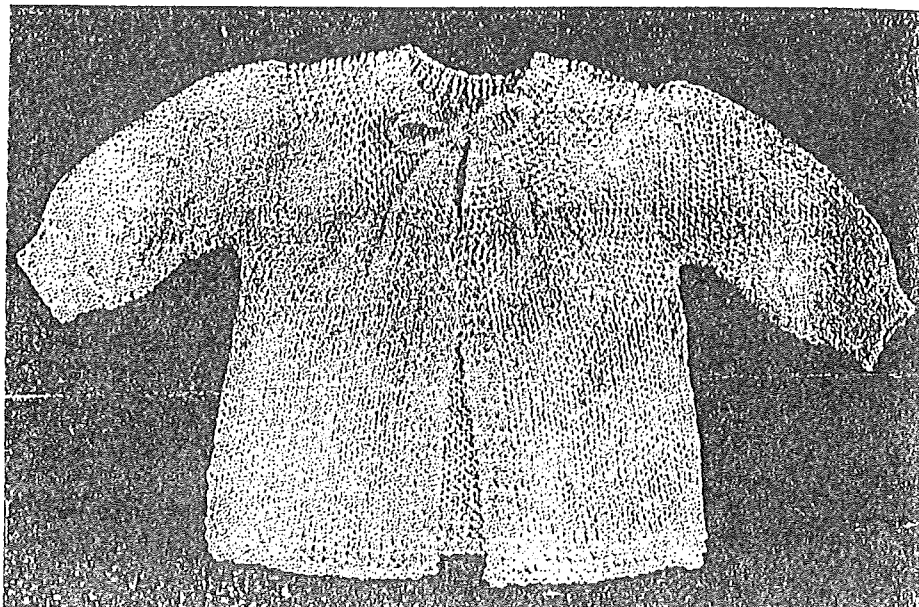
Newborn to 3 Months  
17" Chest  
To 9 Months  
19" Chest

### Materials:

Baby Yarn, One 1 3/4 Oz. Ball  
Knitting Needles, One Pair # 4 and # 10

### Gauge:

On # 4 Needles, 11 Stitches = 2 Inches,  
7 Rows = 1 Inch  
On # 10 Needles, 7 Stitches and 12  
Rows = 1 Inch



### Directions:

For 4 months to 9 months, follow directions in parenthesis ().

Starting at neck, with # 4 needles, cast on 67 (79) sts. Work in K 1, P 1 ribbing for 1". Change to garter stitch (K across row). \*First row, K across, increasing 16 sts. evenly spaced. K even for 5 rows.\* Repeat these 6 rows until 131 (159) sts. Work one more increase 19 sts., for 150 (178) sts. Change to larger needles. Keep first 4 and last 4 sts. garter st. (K each row) and center sts. in stockinette st. (K on right side, P on wrong side). Work until 5" (6)" from beginning, ending on P row.

*Divide For Fronts, Back & Sleeves:* K across first 22 (26) sts. for front, K next 31 (37) sts., place on holder for sleeve, K next 44 (52) sts. for back, K next 31 (37) sts. for sleeve and place on holder, K last 22 (26) sts. for front, K 3, then P back on front, back and front, K 3 at end. Continue in stockinette as before, on these 88 sts. until about 4 1/2" (5 1/2)". Work 4 rows in garter st., then bind off.

*Sleeves:* Pick up sleeve sts. from holder and transfer to # 10 needle. Continue in stockinette st. until 4" (5") from underarm. Change to # 4 needles. Work in K 1, P 1 ribbing for 1". Bind off. Repeat with other sleeve.

*Neck Ties:* Make 2. Cast on 50 (60) sts. K 1 row. Bind off. Sew one end to each side of front at top neck edge.

Optional: Ribbon can be used for neck ties.
