



## Stay Put Shawl

### You Will Need

- 2 hanks TOUCH MOHAIR.
- 1 pair 10 mm needles
- 2 stitch holders

### Abbreviations

- **K** Knit
- **P** Purl

### Instructions

Roll hanks of Touch Yarn into balls before commencing.

Cast on 2 stitches.

Working in garter stitch, increase in first stitch of every row until 60 stitches.

Continue in garter stitch until straight section of work measures 100 cm ( or up to 120 cm if larger size required).

**Next Row:**

\*K1, slip next stitch onto stitch holder, P1, slip next stitch onto stitch holder, repeat from \* to end of row.

Working in K1, P1 rib on stitches on the needle, continue until rib section measures 15 cm.

Slip these stitches onto another stitch holder and break off yarn.

Rejoin wool to stitches on first stitch holder and work in K1 P1 rib to match first rib section until this section measures 15 cm.

Rejoin the pieces as follows:

Working in garter stitch, alternate knitting 1 stitch from the needle and 1 stitch from the stitch holder until there are again 60 stitches on the one needle.

Continue in garter stitch, decreasing 1 st at beginning of every row until there are 2 sts. Cast off.
