

Easy Peazy Shawl 2.0



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Dimensions: Approx- 32" x60"

Materials:

Diamond Luxury Collection Merino Bamboo 50g

70% Merino Wool/30% Bamboo, 110m

Colour 6241 - 7 Skeins (770m total)

Size 4mm/6 , 32" Circ. Needle

Markers (if using)

Gauge: 21st /28Rows St st (although gauge not super important, just a guide)

Note: Project is knit from neck edge down

Cast on 5 Sts.

Set up Row RS: K2, YO, PM, K1, PM, YO,K2

Set up Row WS: K2, Purl to last 2Sts, K2.

Remember to slip Markers throughout if using.

Begin Pattern as follows with Stockinette

Pattern:

STOCKINETTE PATTERN:

Row 1: K2, YO, K to Marker, YO, SM,K1, SM, YO, Knit to last 2 Sts, YO, K2.

Row 2: K2, P to last 2 Sts, K2. (Slip markers)

Repeat Rows 1 & 2, 9 more times for a total of 10 repeats. (20 rows worked)

Next: Garter Ridge Stripe

GARTER RIDGE STRIPE

Row 1: K2, YO, Purl to Marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, Purl to last 2 stitches, YO, K2

Row 2: Knit row

Row 3: K2, YO, Knit to Marker, YO, SM K1, SM, YO, Knit to last 2 stitches, YO, K2

Row 4: K2, Purl to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 5: As row 1

Row 6: As row 2

Next Lace Pattern:

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Easy Peazy Shawl 2.0 cont'd

LACE PATTERN:

Row 1: K2, YO, *(K2Tog,YO)*, rep *to* until 1 st before M,K1, YO, SM, K1,SM,YO, K1,*(YO,SSK)* repeat *to* until last 2 Sts, YO, K2.

Row 2: K2, P to last 2 Sts, K2. (Slip markers)

Repeat Rows 1 & 2 of Lace 8 more times for a total of 9 Repeats. (18 Rows worked).

Continue Patterns established in the following order:

Garter Ridge Stripe

Stockinette Border

Garter Ridge Stripe

Lace Pattern

Repeat 2 times more for a total of 3 times worked

Next:

Garter Border:

RS: K2, YO, Purl to Marker, YO, SM,K1, SM, YO

Purl to last 2 stitches, YO, K2

Next: WS: Knit row.

Next: RS: Bind off.

Weave in ends



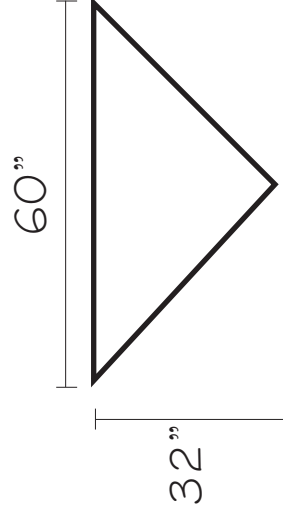


Note: SSK- There are many ways to achieve SSK. I have presented a way that I discovered makes the stitch lay flatter, thanks "Knittinghelp.com".

This Shawl has to be blocked in order for the lace to really open up.

Markers can be used or not. Since I was able to distinguish the center stitch I was able to knit without markers. Newer knitters however, should use markers.

A circular needle was used to accommodate the large number of stitches that are used. Do not join in the round. Work is knit flat



Abbreviations:

- K-Knit BO- bind off P-Purl
- PM- place marker Sts- Stitches
- YO-Yarn Over SM- Slip Marker
- M-Marker K2Tog- Knit 2 stitches together
- SSK- Slip 1 st stitch knitwise on left needle to right needle, Slip 2nd stitch purlwise from left needle onto right needle, insert tip of left needle into front of the 2 slipped stitches, knit these 2 stitches together.

To Read Chart begin a B I . At end of 2nd Row (B2) of Stockinette you will have 11 Sts.
 At end of 20th Row (B20) will have 47 Sts. At end of 2nd Row of Garter Ridge Stripe
 will have 51 Sts. Keep reading count downwards then to the right for stitch counting.
